eAppendix. US News & World Report Gastroenterology and Gastrointestinal Surgery Ranking Methodology

1) Eligibility criteria for US News and World Report ranking consideration requires a hospital to

fulfill at least one of the following conditions:

- a. considered a teaching hospital
- b. affiliation with a medical school
- c. minimum of 200 beds
- minimum of 100 beds with concomitant availability of at least four out of eight advanced medical technologies deemed significant by US News Best Hospitals (1).
- 2) Eligibility for specialty ranking:
 - Defined number of discharges for specialty-specific diagnoses (high volume of discharge is a surrogate for experience)
 - In 2017, for the Gastroenterology and Gastrointestinal Surgery specialty ranking required a surgical discharge threshold of 111 Medicare patients.
- 3) Ranked by a weighted scoring system:
 - a. outcomes (including risk-adjusted mortality)
 - b. structure (hospital resources allocated for patient care)
 - c. process (based on expert opinion)
 - d. patient safety quality indicators.
