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#### **Table SI-1. CCI Scoring System**

NOTE: The scoring system depicted in this table was used to compute the CCI scores used in the admissions and mortality models (see Methods and Results section in manuscript). It is a modification of the system designed by Quan et al.

### **Table SI-2. Hierarchy Categories**

Within each hierarchy category, the milder condition should not contribute to the CCI score if the more severe condition applies even though codes for both may appear for an individual patient in a claims dataset.
