

Supplemental Table 2. Examples of responses classified as *poor*, *ok*, and *good*. Two examples of *poor* responses are included to show the difference between an incomplete and an incorrect answer.

Knowledge Response Examples	
<i>Poor</i> (incomplete)	“One can be managed by dietary restrictions.”
<i>Poor</i> (incorrect)	“Type one is the early stage and type two is the middle stage”
<i>Ok</i>	“Type 2 Diabetes is an issue where the body does not use insulin effectively whereas with Type 1 Diabetes the body has a lack of insulin.”
<i>Good</i>	“Type 1 cannot be cured, and the person has to take insulin every day. Type 2 can be controlled by diet, diet and medication or sometimes the need for insulin is also required.”
