Knowledge Response Examples	
Poor (incomplete)	"One can be managed by dietary restrictions."
Poor (incorrect)	"Type one is the early stage and type two is the middle stage"
Ok	"Type 2 Diabetes is an issue where the body does not use insulin effectively whereas with Type 1 Diabetes the body has a lack of insulin."
Good	"Type 1 cannot be cured, and the person has to take insulin every day. Type 2 can be controlled by diet, diet and medication or sometimes the need for insulin is also required."
