

Supplemental Figure 2. Correlations among phenotypes chosen for analysis. Each scatter plot (lower left triangle of the matrix) shows the correlations between phenotypes. In the upper right triangle of the matrix are the Pearson (r) and Spearman (ρ) correlation coefficients for each pairwise comparison. Most correlations are small ($r < 0.5$), and those with larger correlations show distinct “clusters” or non-linearities, suggesting that the phenotypes are not redundant.
