definition	CFS score	
Non Frail	1	The patient is extremely active (and this is noted in the history) and presented with no known comorbidity.
	2	The patient presented with no known comorbidity
	3	The patient presented either with one or more known comorbidity, all controlled by medication
	4	The patient presented with at least one known comorbidity controlled by multiple medications, two to four comorbidities not controlled by medication, or five or more comorbidities.
Frail	5	The patient required assistive devices to ambulate or required oxygen supplementation.
	6	The patient required outside help to perform daily activities.
	7	The patient presented with a known terminal illness and outside help to perform daily activities.
