



Figure S5. Co-circulation of West Nile virus genotypes WN02 and SW03. Since the emergence of WN02 (blue) and SW03 (green) in 2001, the genotypes continue co-circulate in locations throughout the U.S. For example, both genotypes were detected during the same years and vector species (A) in Maricopa County, Arizona (Hepp et al. 2018) (B) throughout California (Duggal et al. 2015), and (C) throughout New York (Bialosuknia et al. 2019).
