

**SUPPLEMENTARY FIG. S1.** Pain drawings from baseline 2 (B2) and evaluation 3 (E3) for 3 participants who experienced pain. Color coding of pains are as follows: musculoskeletal pain (gray), at-level neuropathic pain (green), below-level neuropathic pain (red), and intensities are noted (scale 1–10). (**A**) At B2, participant BC02 experienced two musculoskeletal pains (bilateral shoulders and right elbow) and one below-level neuropathic pain (right leg and lower back). (**B**) At E3, musculoskeletal (neck, right elbow/arm/hand) and below-level neuropathic (right leg) pains were present. (**C**) Participant BC03 experienced musculoskeletal (midline back) and at-level neuropathic (left torso) pains at B2 and (**D**) these remained constant at E3. (**E**) Participant BC07 experienced musculoskeletal pains in the neck and right shoulder areas at B2 and (**F**) in the neck, right shoulder, and right upper arm at E3.
