Questionnaire # 1

The purpose of the following questions is to assess the relative importance of the criteria for your decision about Down syndrome prenatal screening. Then, select its importance, as in the example below (Note: 1 is “Equal importance” and 9 “Extreme importance”; if A and B have equal importance to you, circle number 1).
