
Supplementary figure 1: Flow diagram of followed procedure



Legend: Flow diagram of followed procedures. We included clinically diagnosed EOA, DCD and HHM patients. Step I: Video recording of SARA and PBS performances. Step II: phenotypic assessment of video-recorded motor behavior. Step III: Scoring of video-recorded SARA and PBS performances. Step IV: Re-assessment after receiving standardized instructions for EOA recognition As EOA was completely discerned from HT in step II, step IV concerned the re-phenotyping of the inhomogeneously assessed EOA and DCD patients. The time interval between step II and III was more than 6 weeks. The time interval between step III and IV was more than 6 months. EOA = Early Onset Ataxia; DCD = Developmental Coordination Disorder; HMI = Hypotonic motor function inaccuracy; SARA = Scale and Assessement for Rating of Ataxia; PBS = Pediatric Balance Scale; phen. = phenotypic; ped. = pediatric
