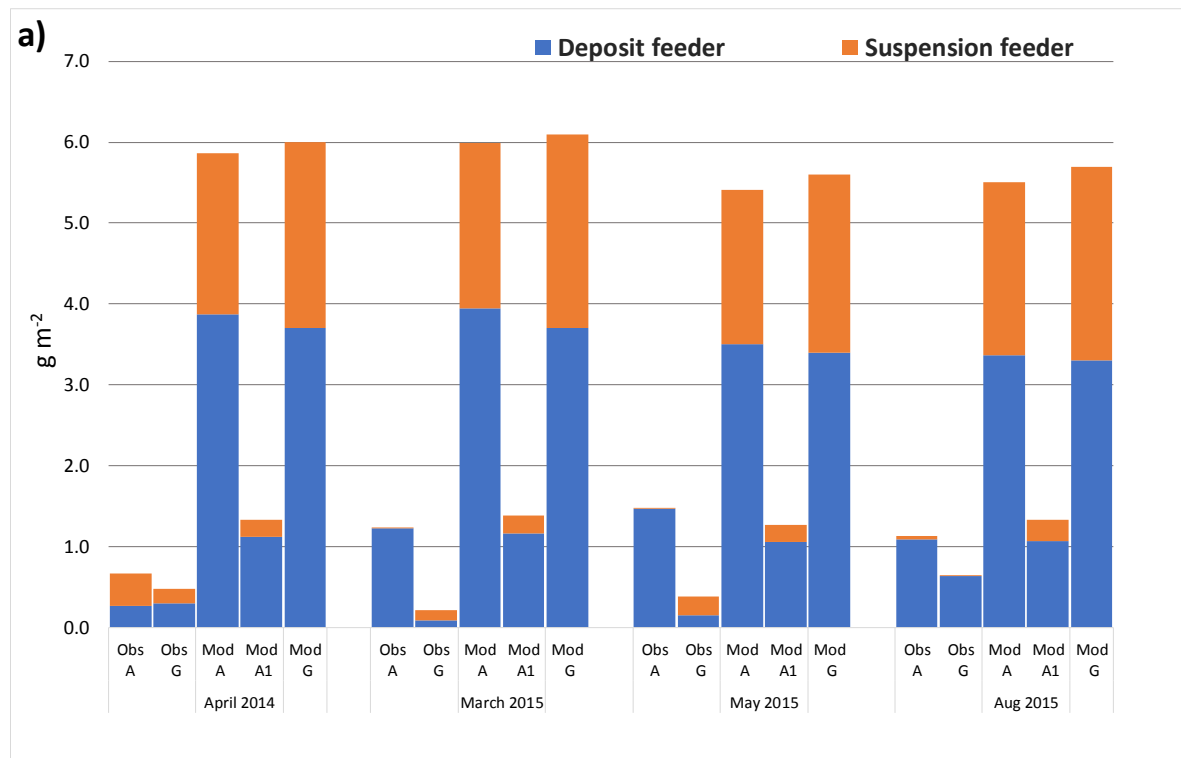


Figure a: Benthic macrofauna model-data comparison at sites A and G. Observations replicate means (5 samples).

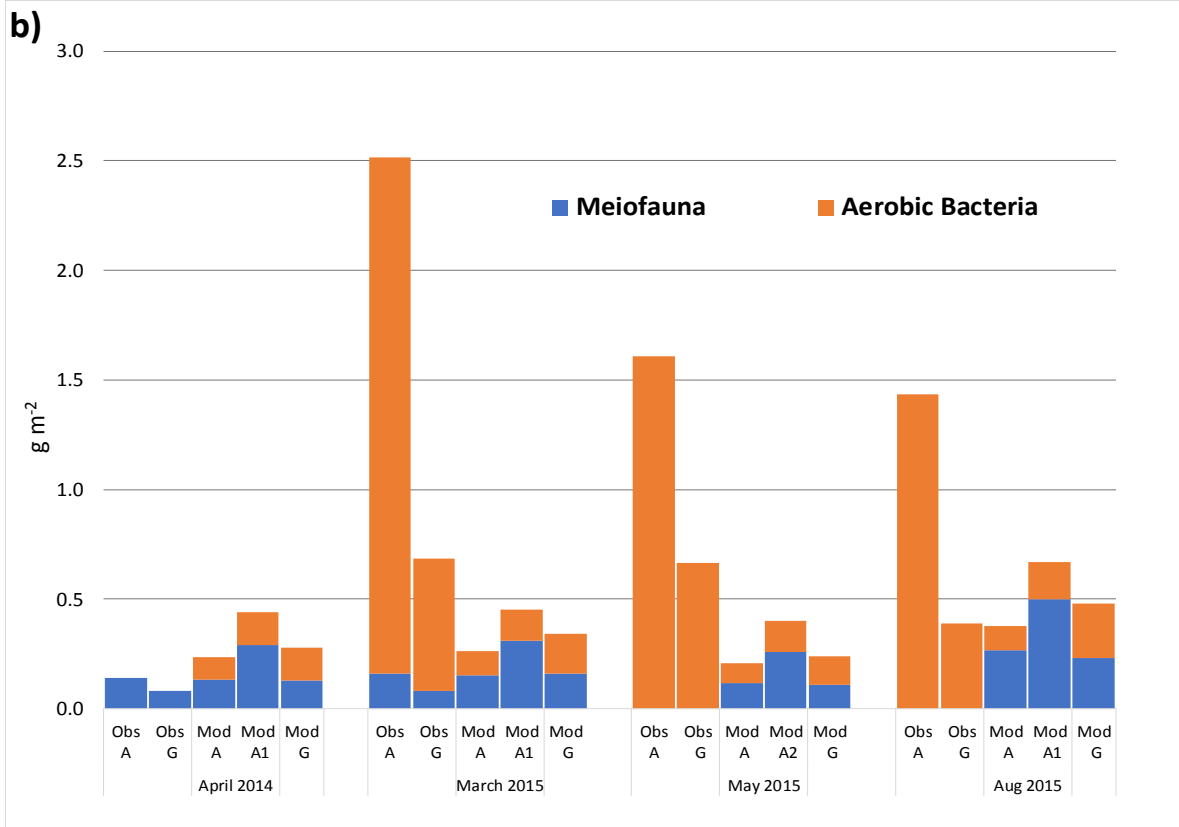


Figure b: Meiofaunal and aerobic bacteria biomass (g C m^{-2}) model-data comparison at sites A and G. Observations replicate means (5 samples).
