

Supplementary Figure 2. Example of the Bereitschaftspotential in functional jerks. Recordings of electroencephalography (EEG) signals from the C3 electrode (upper trace) and EMG signals from the right biceps muscle (bottom trace) from a patient with functional right arm jerks. Forty trials were averaged. The EEG recordings show a Bereitschaftspotential, which is a slow, negative potential, with an onset about 1,500 ms before EMG onset. Time 0 = EMG onset.
