



Figure S1. Directed Acyclic Graph (DAG) representing the association between Occupational Stress and glycemic alterations.

The symbols ► and ■ denote the exposure and outcome variables, respectively. The pink rectangles represent the variables that simultaneously precede the exposure and the outcome, and the blue rectangles indicate the variables that precede only the outcome. The green lines represent the causal paths (mediators) and the pink lines indicate the paths that potentially skew the estimates of the studied association (confounders).
