	3. More than 50% progression of lesion as evident from CT scan over the past 48 hours.
Critical	Positive RT-PCR and definitive CT imaging with at least one of
	the following items:
	1. Intubation needed due to respiratory failure.
	2. Shock.
	3. Multiple organ dysfunction requiring intensive care unit treatment.
