 Consider all IBD patients at high risk

1. Hands hygiene

2. Use of PPE

3. Cleaning of the surface



- FFP2 or FFP3
- Goggles or face shield
- Long sleeves water – resistant gowns
- Gloves
- Hairnet

- Common detergent (chlorine containing)
- Ultraviolet irradiation
- Ozone

Endoscopy in a negative pressure room or open windows 1 h before and after the procedure
