Authors have now addressed most of the peer review comments. There are small grammatical and syntax errors that will be likely picked up during copy-editing. My only suggestion to the authors is to document at which study of the review was the PROSPERO protocol submitted (e.g. this systematic review protocol was registered with PROSPERO before commencing data extraction // or before conducting the meta-analyses). If the protocol was submitted after the meta-analyses were conducted, it is not a prospective protocol and authors should remove it.
