Inclusion criteria	Type of articles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Full-text peer-reviewed research articles (primary and secondary research) - Grey literature (e.g. reports and book chapters)
	Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - English language
	Geographic context	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Worldwide
	Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No restrictions
	PrEP delivery model	<p>PrEP provision in real world setting with mentioning of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Infrastructural setting of PrEP delivery AND - Target population for PrEP AND - PrEP provider AND - Used delivery channel

Exclusion criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Non-oral administration methods of PrEP - Articles focusing on steps in the PrEP care continuum not related to PrEP provision (e.g. creating awareness and assessing eligibility) - Non-research articles not discussing PrEP service delivery as its main focus. - Demonstration projects not studying PrEP service delivery aspects as its main focus.
