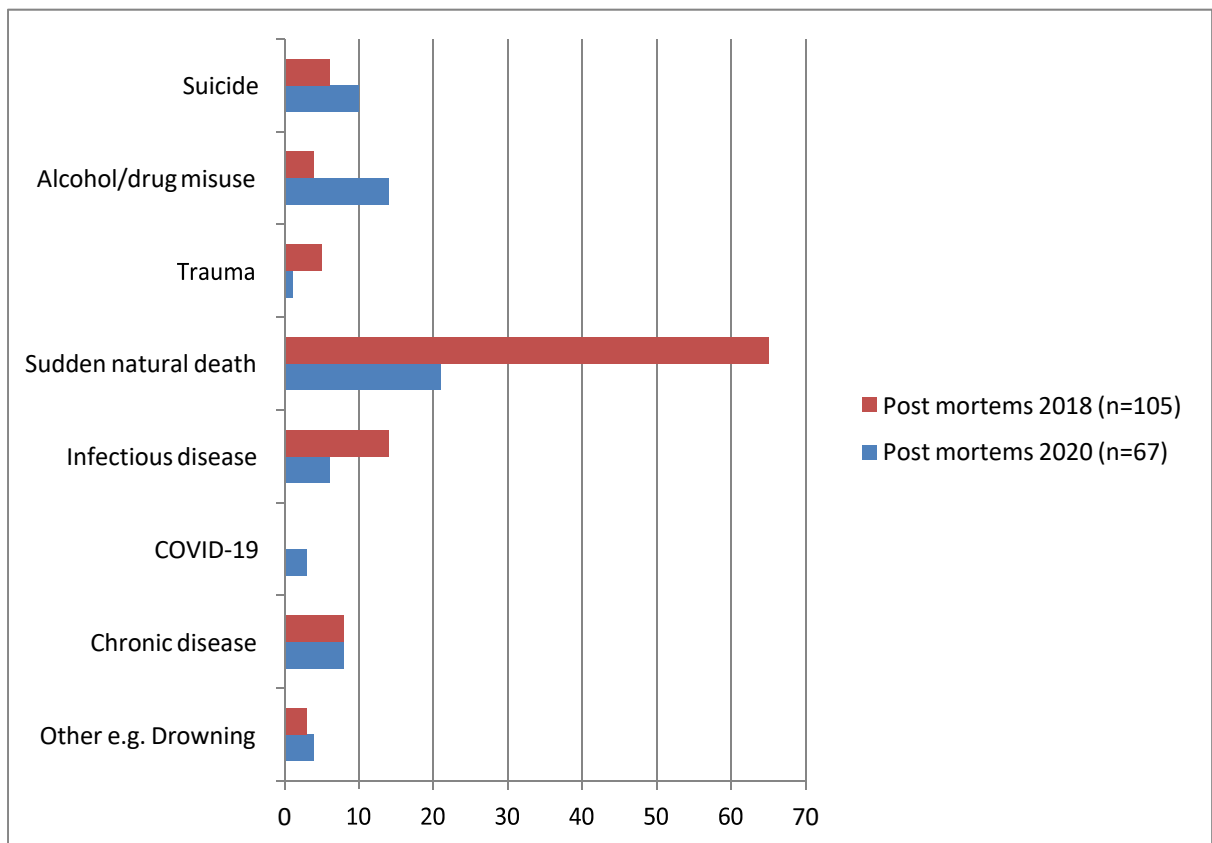


Figure: Categories of death as ascertained at post mortem examination from 23rd March to 23rd May in 2018 and 2020. A significant reduction in post mortems identifying sudden natural death ($\chi^2(1,n=172)=15.28,p<0.0001$) and a significant increase in post mortems identifying suicide ($\chi^2(1,n=172)=4.11,p=0.0426$) and drug / alcohol misuse ($\chi^2(1,n=172)=12.74,p=0.0004$) was experienced in our caseload.
