Signs and symptoms classified as potentially related to SARS-CoV-2 on nursing change in condition documentation:

- Fever (temperature 100.0F or higher)
- Hypoxia (oxygen saturation less than 92% or a 3% decline from baseline)
- Tachycardia (heart rate greater than 100)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chest congestion
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Decreased oral intake
- Altered mental status
- Confusion
- Malaise
- Chills
- Anosmia
- Rhinorrhea
- Nasal congestion
- Sore throat
- Respiratory infection
- Respiratory arrest
