"Use of TOLAC Prediction Calculators Among Midwives and Collaborators"

Calculators predicting TOLAC success have become widely popular as a counseling aid when women have a history of cesarean. There is little documentation in the literature regarding how these calculators are ACTUALLY USED by providers. The information gathered here will help document how midwives and their physician colleagues use predictive calculators in caring for women facing trial of labor versus elective repeat cesarean.
