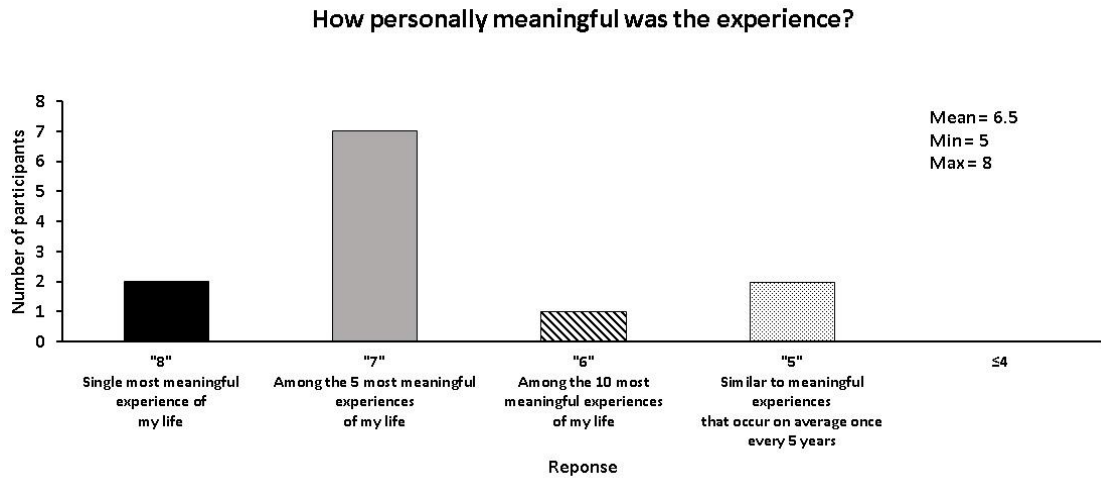

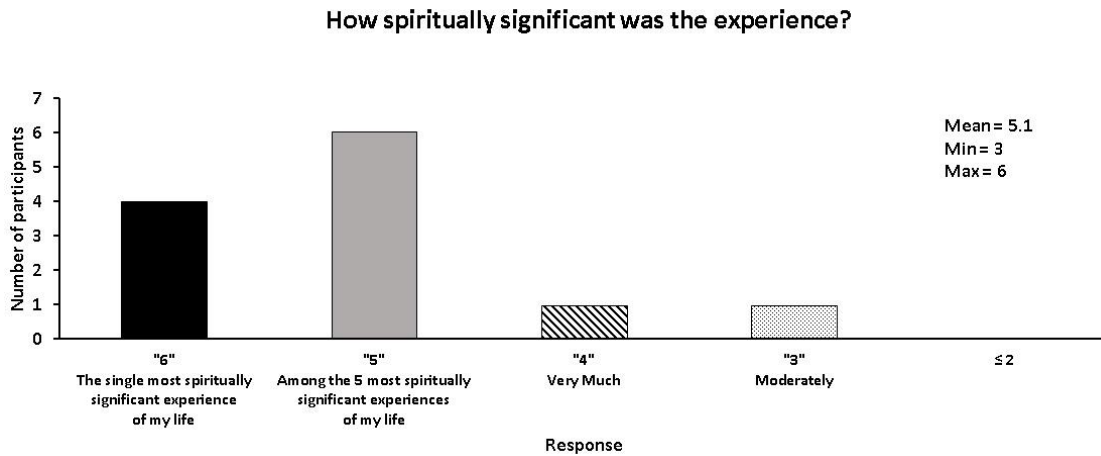
Participant order randomized. yes =participant achieved a complete mystical experience as defined below. x = dose was not administered. Data from each of the four Mystical Experience Questionnaire (MEQ) subscales were expressed as a percentage of the maximum possible score. A “complete” mystical experience was defined as scoring greater than or equal to 60% on each of the four subscales: mystical, transcendence of time and space, positive mood, and ineffability; the criteria used were determined based on previous studies (Griffiths et al., 2006, 2011; Pahnke, 1969).
