Psychosocial	 What relationships were important to you in the last year of your family member's life? What was your relationship with your family member like? What relationships were helpful to you? What were your emotions like during this time? Were you surprised by your emotions? Why or why not?
Practical	 What tasks did you have to have to complete for your family member? What kind of services did you use after-death? Were the tasks that you had to complete things you expected, or had done before? What was helpful in completing these tasks?
Spiritual	 What are your beliefs around death and dying? What beliefs did your family member have? What traditions or practices did you follow when your family member was dying or afterwards?
