<b>Preparedness Domain</b>	<b>Questions</b>
Medical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What events stand out to you from the last year of your family member's life?</li> <li>• Were these events that you expected?</li> <li>• What do you think was helpful in preparing for these events?</li> </ul>
Psychosocial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What relationships were important to you in the last year of your family member's life?</li> <li>• What was your relationship with your family member like?</li> <li>• What relationships were helpful to you?</li> <li>• What were your emotions like during this time?</li> <li>• Were you surprised by your emotions? Why or why not?</li> </ul>
Practical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What tasks did you have to have to complete for your family member?</li> <li>• What kind of services did you use after-death?</li> <li>• Were the tasks that you had to complete things you expected, or had done before?</li> <li>• What was helpful in completing these tasks?</li> </ul>
Spiritual	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are your beliefs around death and dying?</li> <li>• What beliefs did your family member have?</li> <li>• What traditions or practices did you follow when your family member was dying or afterwards?</li> </ul>
