Figure S1. Trends in the proportion of patients undergoing surgery for infective endocarditis over time by Poisson log-linear regression. Trends are depicted as green dashed lines. There was no difference in the proportion of patients undergoing surgery over time (IRR 1.01; 95% CI, 0.97–1.05; p = 0.688).

Figure S2. Trends in the median age of patients with infective endocarditis over time by Poisson log-linear regression. Trends are depicted as green dashed lines. The median patient age tended to increase over time, although not statistically significant (IRR 1.01; 95% CI, 0.99-1.03; p=0.570).
