(A) SIRS criteria. (B) qSOFA score. (C) NEWS score. (D) REMS score. Hollow circles denote groups of predicted risk used to fit a smoothed curve. Vertical line through hollow circles denote 95% confidence intervals. The distribution of non-events of the outcome (0) and events of the outcome (1) by expected probability are denoted by the rug plot (light grey) along the x axis.
