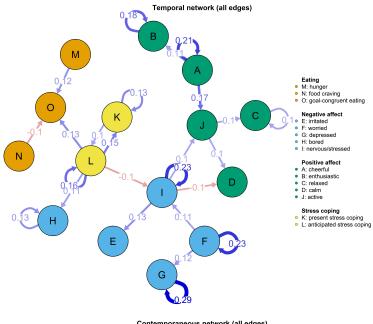
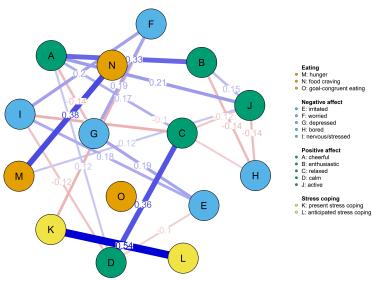

## Between-subject network (all edges)

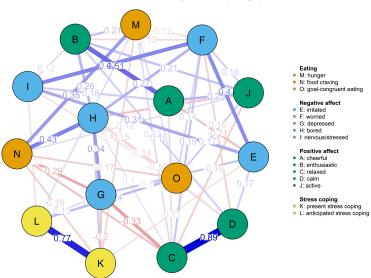


Figure 5. Temporal, contemporaneous and between-subject networks without significance threshold. Note. Please see the legend above for meanings of coloured circles as well as abbreviations. All associations that show effect sizes of r > .1 are displayed in the networks. Blue edges indicate a positive association, whereas red edges indicate a negative one. The coefficients are displayed on or next to the respective
