1st phase

began on April 27^{th}

Service activities and trade

- opening of all stores that were not integral part of malls
- opening service activities that do not require close contact with customers

Public transport

- start of public transport in urban and suburban areas
- high-speed ferries for islands were reintroduced

Other activities

- possibility to start training sessions for top athletes
- preparing priority groups of students to take the state exam
- opening of libraries, museums, galleries, antique shops and bookstores

2nd phase

began on May 4th

Service activities

 restarting service activities (barbers, pedicurists and hairdressers), under the condition that special epidemiological measures are respected

Health care system

 public and private health care system can start working in the full extent, under the condition that special epidemiological measures are respected

Service activities

- opening of shopping malls, under the condition that special epidemiological measures are respected
- operation of restaurants exclusively on outdoor areas and terraces

Other activities

- allowing public gatherings of up to 10 persons, with respecting measures of social distance
- rehearsals of artists and cultural workers, can be performed individually and in small groups
- the decision to ban leaving the place of residence and permanent residence also expired
- possibility to organize cultural programs and events (indoors and outdoors)
- $-\,$ announcement for opening sports, fitness, and recreation centers from May $13^{th},$ and pools from May 18^{th}

Education

- start of work of school institutions for work with children from the first to the fourth grade
- possibility of performing laboratory, artistic and clinical practices at universities
