

Supplementary Table 2. Postoperative intraretinal fluid cysts and anterior chamber cells following cataract surgery by occurrence of intraoperative complications. Intraretinal fluid and post-operative inflammation did not appear to be associated with the presence of intraoperative complications. Approximately one quarter of participants demonstrated evidence of intraretinal fluid and a slight majority of participants had mild or greater inflammation in the anterior chamber at one month or beyond.
