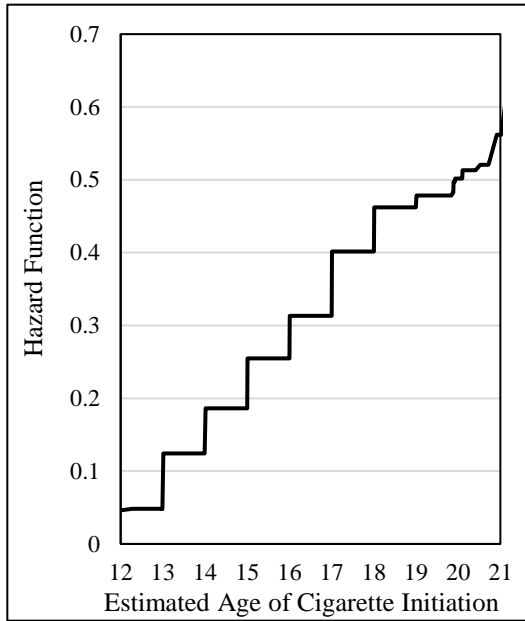
eFigure 2. Estimated Age of Initiation of Cigarette Use Outcomes by Sex

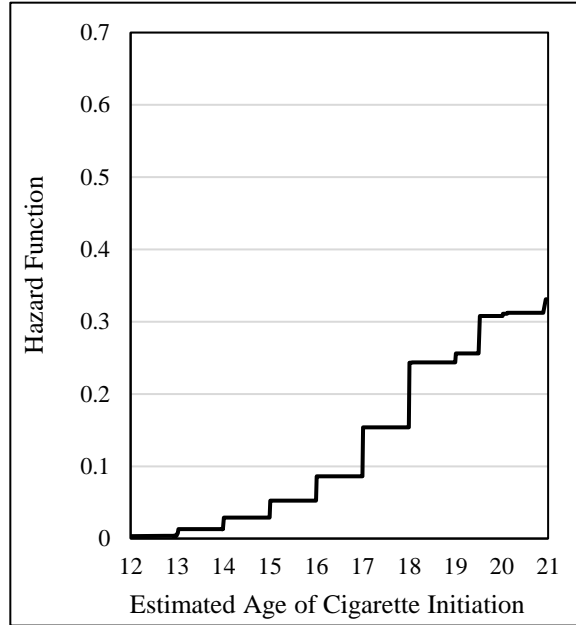

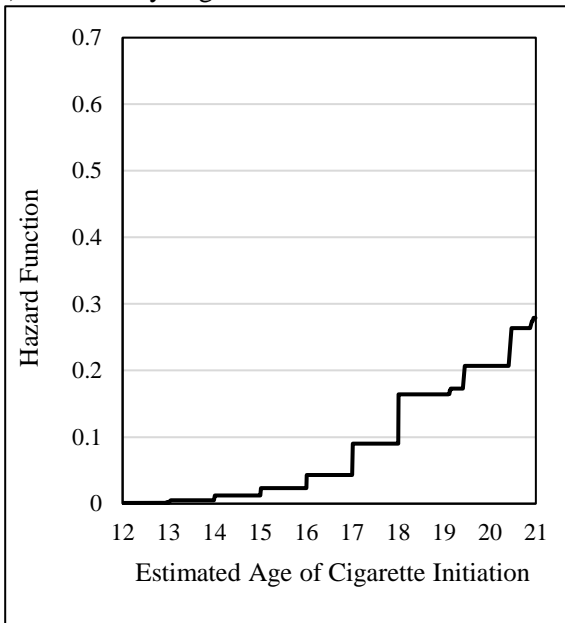
(a) Susceptibility to Cigarette Initiation



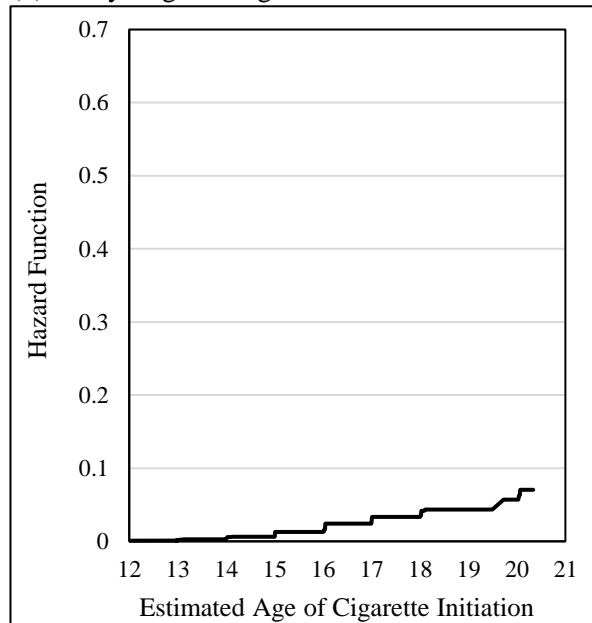
(b) Ever Cigarette Initiation



(c) Past 30-day Cigarette Initiation

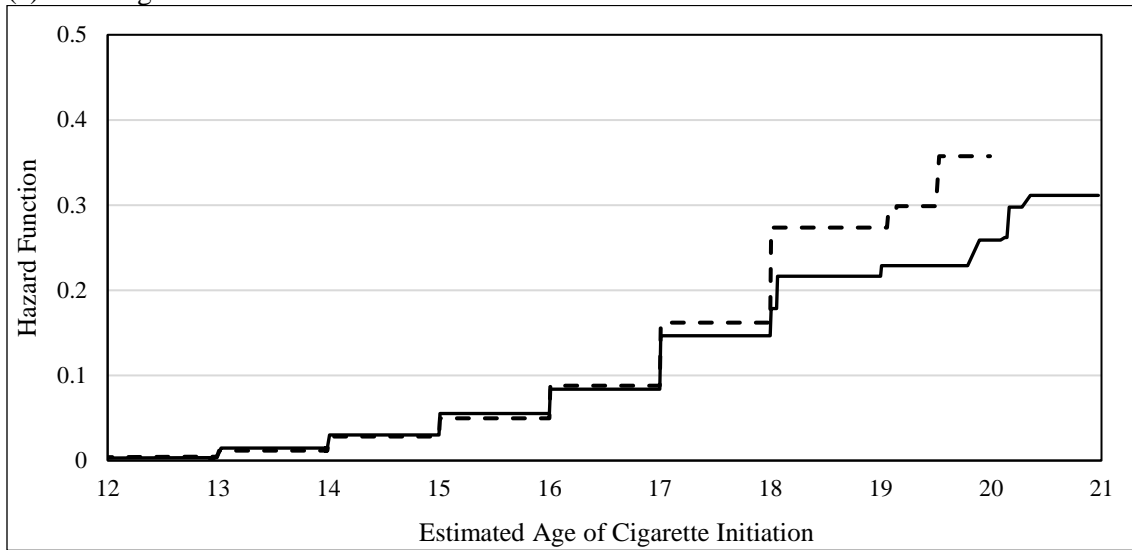

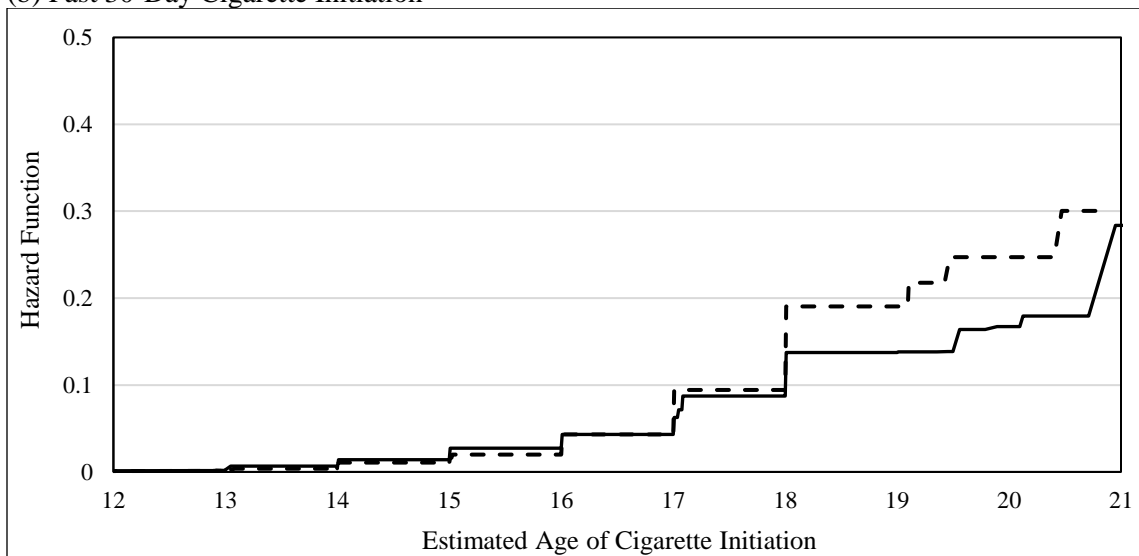


eFigure 2. Age of Initiation of Cigarette Use Outcomes by Sex

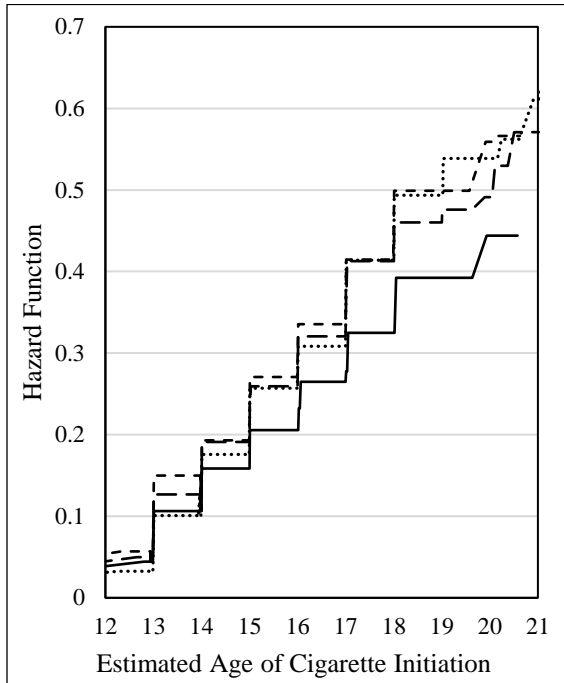

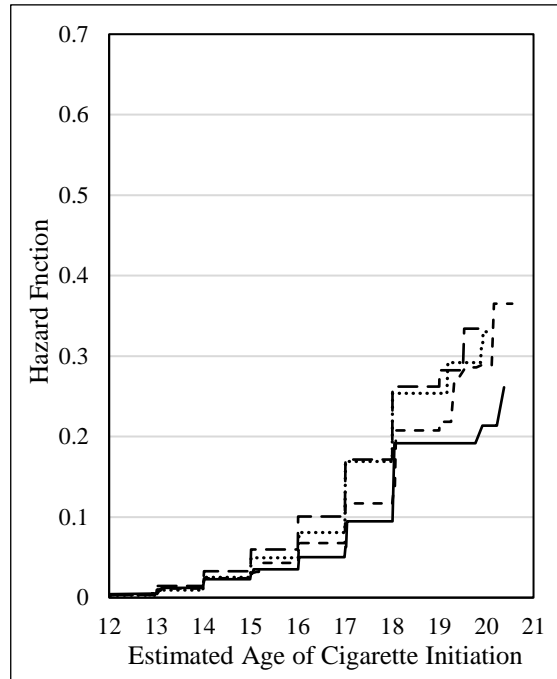

eFigure3. Age of Initiation of Cigarette Use Outcomes by Race/Ethnicity.

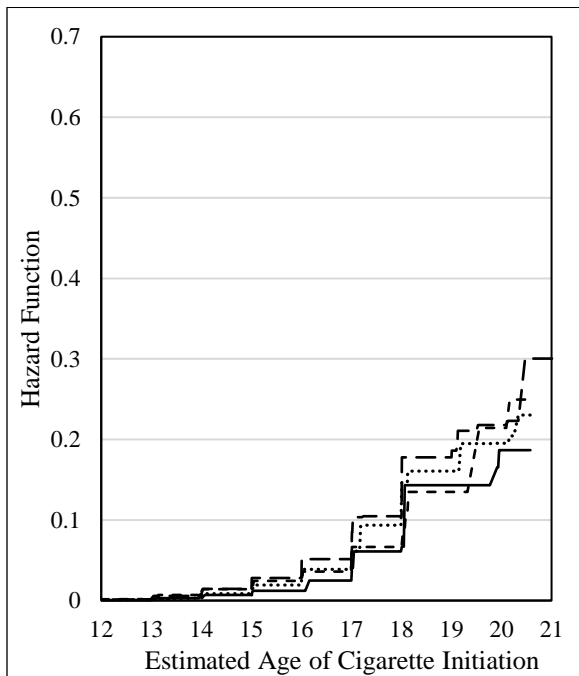
(a) Susceptibility to cigarette initiation



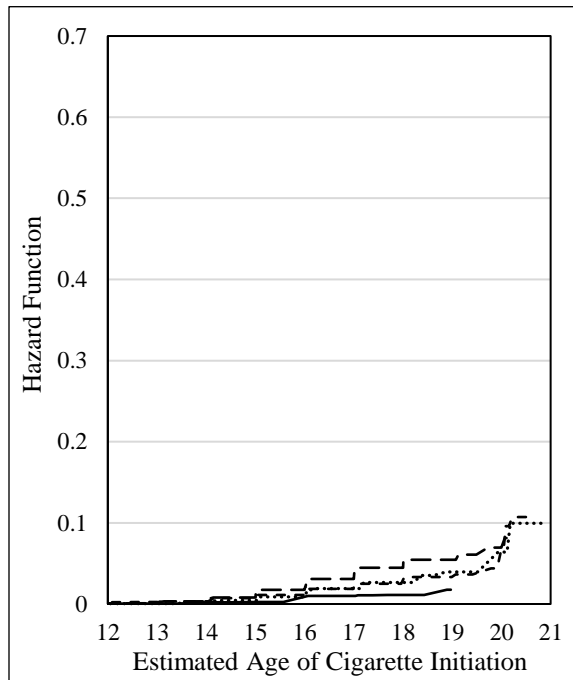
