Fatigue	mild, able to continue normal activities (PS 1)	impairment of normal daily activity or bed rest <50% of waking hours (PS 2)	in bed or in chair >50% of waking hours (PS 3)	bed ridden or unable to care for self (PS 4)
Neuropathy	mild paresthesias, loss of deep tendon reflexes	mild or moderate objective sensory loss; moderate paresthesias	severe objective, sensory loss or paresthesias that interfere with function	---
