

Supplementary Figure 2 - Direct measurements of Cotinine levels predict smoking behaviour from the self-reported questionaire (yes - Y /no - N). The Receiver Operating characteristic (ROC) curve shows an area under the curve of 0.938 (confidence interval 87.9-98.2% - $p = 1.0157 \, e$ -20)), with a 90% sensitivity and 80% specificity for cotinine measurements; of note, the threshold for smokers was here calculated to be 1.53 ng/ml, while 7 subjects who self-reported as non-smokers had cotinine levels >25 ng/ml at storage day 10 (arrows).
