



Supplementary file 1. Training dates of the 23 participating General Practitioners (GP).

Each circle is a GP. White circles are GPs randomly allocated to step 1 (early) training period. Black circles are GPs allocated to step 2 (late) period. GPs in step 1 were planned to undergo training first, and then approximately 9 months later, the step 2 GPs trained. However, as shown in the figure, two training periods did not eventuate, and often GPs in either group trained together. This clearly shows the original stepped-wedge cRCT intervention design was not achieved.
