NLR, neutrophil-to-lymphocyte ratio; PLR, platelet-to-lymphocyte ratio.




Figure S2 The correlation between indicators and prognosis in nonsmoking female lung cancer patients

**: There was a significant correlation at the 0.01 level (bilateral); *: There was a significant correlation at the 0.05 level (bilateral).




Figure S3 The correlation between indicators and prognosis in smoking female lung cancer patients

**: There was a significant correlation at the 0.01 level (bilateral); *: There was a significant correlation at the 0.05 level (bilateral).




Figure S4 The correlation between indicators and prognosis in male lung cancer patients
