Tip 5	Build rapport with your respondents
Tip 6	Remember you are a co-creator of the data
Tip 7	Talk less and listen more
Tip 8	Allow yourself to adjust the interview guide
Tip 9	Be prepared to handle unanticipated emotions
Tip 10	Transcribe the interviews in good time
Tip 11	Check the data
Tip 12	Initiate analysis early
