
RAPID TEST FOR SAFE USE OF PRIMAQUINE

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE RAPID TEST:

1) Test must be done at room temperature. Open the envelope and clean the patient's finger with alcohol pad.





2) Prick the fingertip and collect blood with the single use pipette. Squeeze the bulb of pipette to transfer **blood** to the **blood** to the square hole marked witch the **letter 'S'**.





3) Add 2 drops of reagent to the round hole marked with the letter "A". Wait for at least 10 minutes and no more than 20 minutes in order to read test results.





RESULTS:

PRIMAQUINE CAN BE USED DAILY:

A **purple color** indicates that the patient **CAN** use daily primaquine.



PRIMAQUINE CANNOT BE USED DAILY:

If there is no color change, or if the result is a very faint purple color, the patient **CANNOT** use daily primaquine.






INVALID TEST RESULTBlood does not flow properly.



DECISION TREE:



WHAT TO REMEMBER DURING THE TEST:

- Caution when handing blood and disposing contaminated materials.
- Follow product instructions carefully.
- If the envelope is damaged in any way, the test material should be discarded.
- Do not reuse test devices.
