
Supplemental Figure. Confounder-adjusted risk ratio by proposed confounder and a range of possible associations between the confounder and suicide on the odds ratio scale.

Geographic region	Restriction (only in PA) and matching (by county)	Geographic region; urbanicity
Major depressive disorder	Analytic adjustment	CIDI major depressive disorder
Conduct disorder	Analytic adjustment	CIDI conduct disorder
Substance use disorder	Analytic adjustment	CIDI substance use disorder

*Specifically, matching on the Hollingshead Four Factor Scale, a scale which measures socioeconomic status via the four domains of marital status, employment status, educational attainment, and occupation type.
