## SDG1: No poverty

End poverty in all its forms everywhere. **Linked to** Social security & Income

## SDG2: Zero hunger

End hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture. **Linked to** safe food, adequate nutrition

## SDG3: Good health & well-being

Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages. **Linked to** the entitlement to equal and timely access to basic health services and protection against the financial effects of ill health.

## SDG4: Quality education

Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all. **Linked to** health-related education and information.



## SDG6: Clean water & sanitation

Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all. **Linked to** safe drinking water & adequate sanitation.

## SDG8: Decent work & economic growth

Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all. **Linked to** healthy working conditions.

## SDG11: Sustainable cities & communities

Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable. **Linked to** decent housing, community participation in health.

## SDG16: Peace, justice & strong institutions

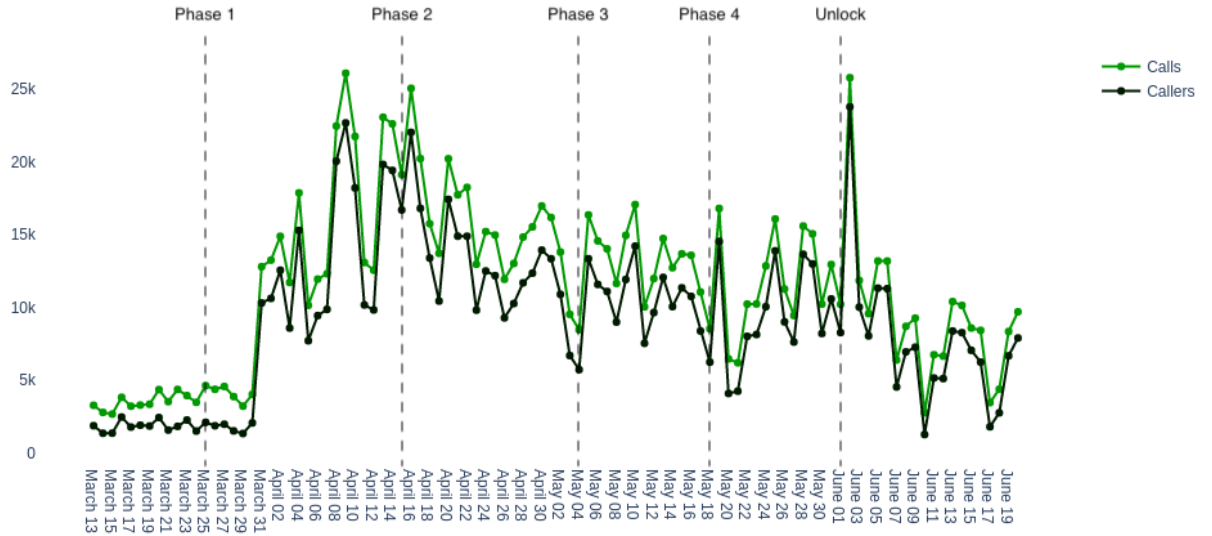

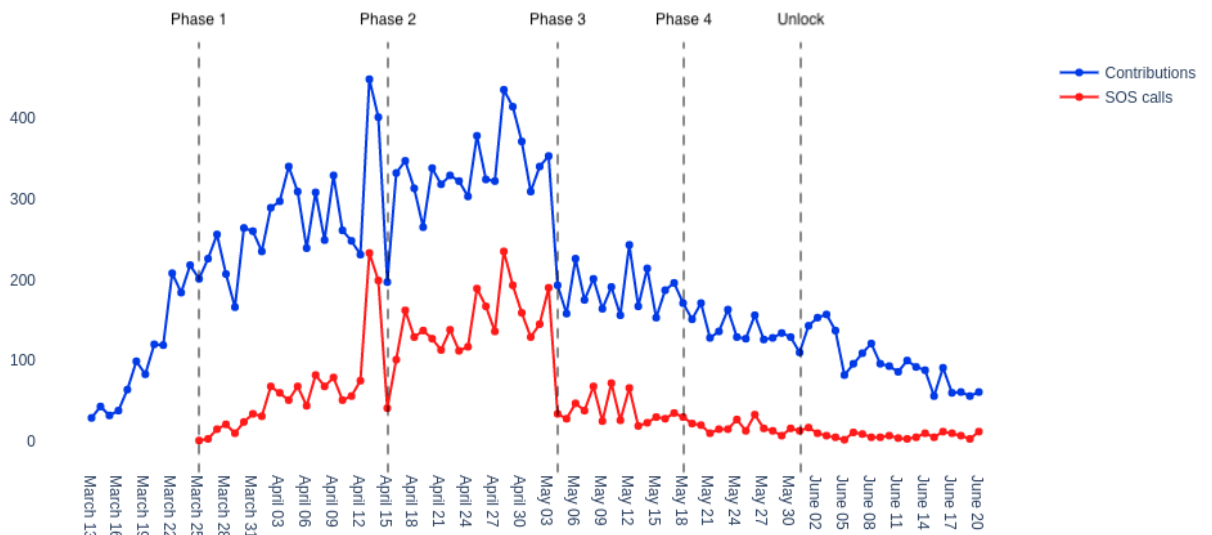

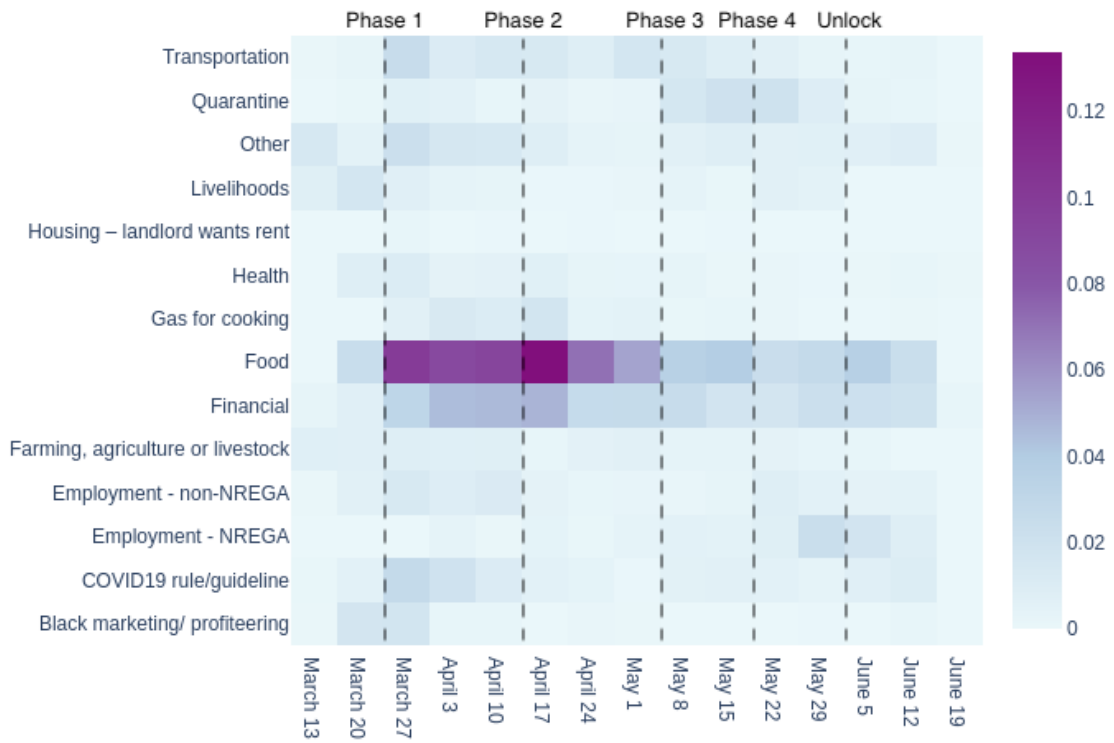
Supplementary figure 2. Temporal distribution of total calls and callers over the 100-day analysis period.



Supplementary figure 3. Temporal distribution of total contributions and SOS messages over the 100-day analysis period.



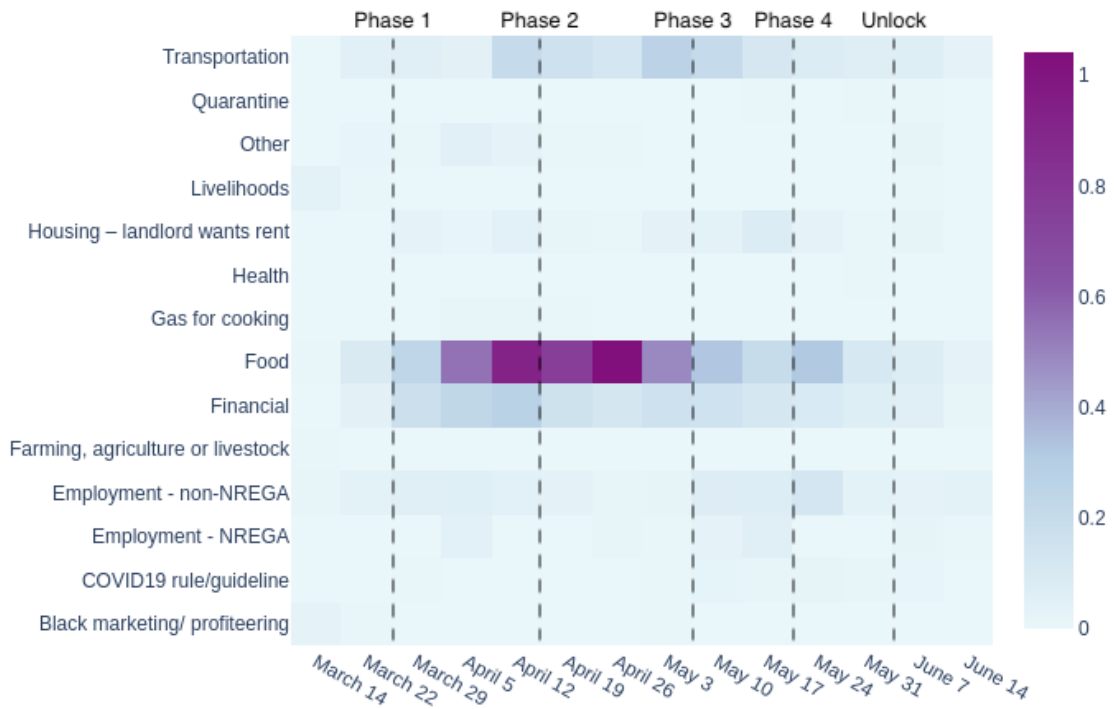

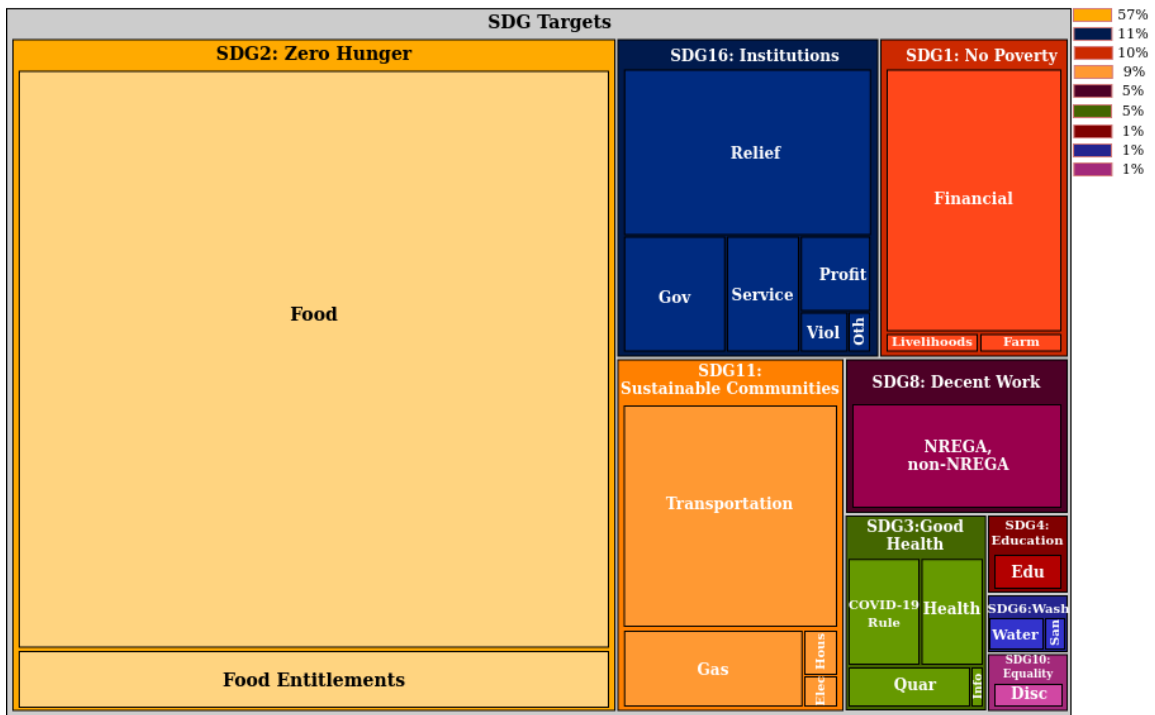

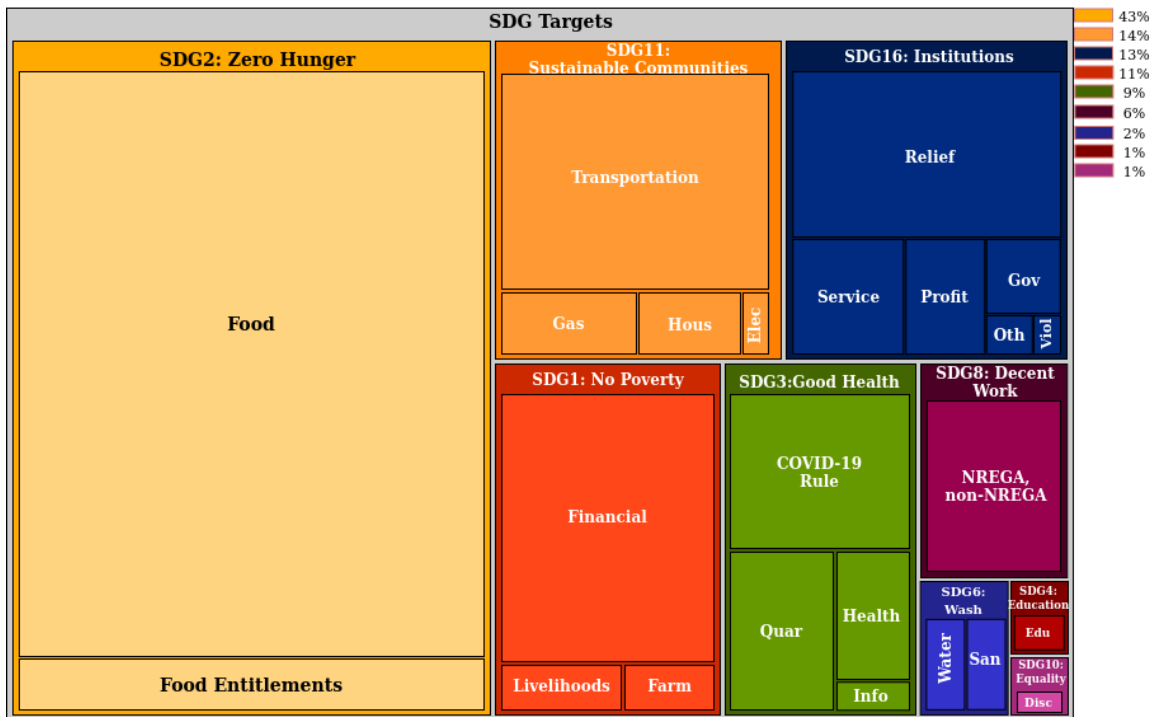
