Supplemental Results

Vocational Outcomes

Overall, we observed 85.4% of the Pre-ETS+VIT-TAY group compared to 69.6% of the Pre-ETS only group obtained employment (competitive, non-competitive, or informal), an internship, or a volunteer position by 6-month follow-up ($\chi^2=2.5$, p=0.06; OR=2.6, CI=0.94, 7.0, p=0.06).

We evaluated vocational outcomes among autistic youth randomized to use VIT-TAY who self-identified as actively seeking employment within six months (i.e., job seekers) or beyond six months (or unknown) (i.e., non-job-seekers). Job-seekers who used VIT-TAY appeared to be more competitively employed than non-job-seekers who used VIT-TAY (33.3% vs. 16.7%; χ^2 =1.8, p=0.09; OR=2.5, CI= 0.79, 7.88, p=0.09), but this finding did not attain significance. Additionally, employment, internships, and volunteer work have all been identified as critical vocational outcomes among transition age autistic youth (Test et al., 2009). We observed that the rate of obtaining any vocational outcome (employment, internship, or volunteering) did not differ between Pre-ETS+VIT-TAY job-seekers (n=24, 87.5%) and Pre-ETS only job-seekers (n=16, 75.0%) (χ^2 =1.0, p=0.15; OR=2.33, CI=0.58, 9.37; p=0.16). Meanwhile, non-job-seekers from the Pre-ETS+VIT-TAY group (n=23) appeared more likely than non-job-seekers from the Pre-ETS only group (n=7) to obtain a vocational outcome (83.3% vs. 57.1%; χ^2 =2.13, p=0.08; OR=3.8, CI=0.80, 17.60, p=0.08), but this finding did not attain significance.
