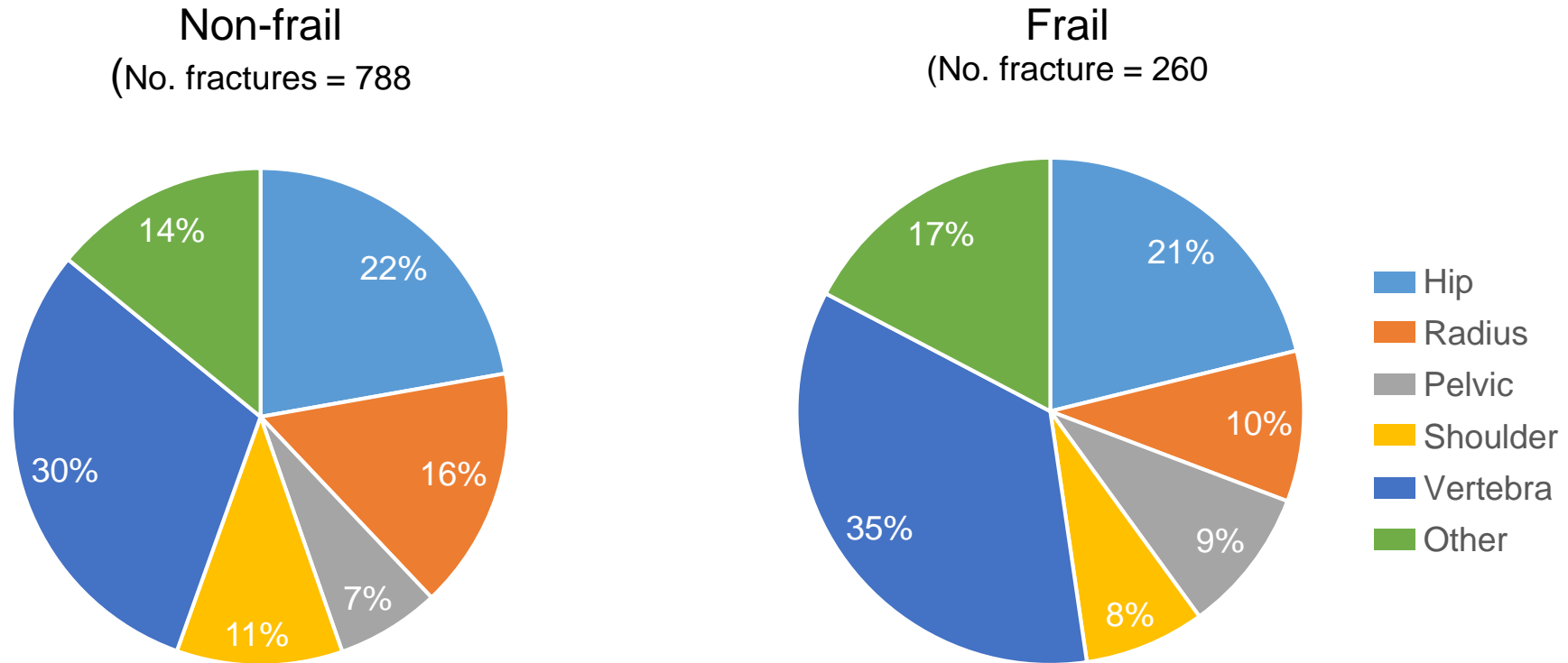


Supplementary Fig. 1 Distribution of fracture types at the end of the study (October 2012) based on frailty status at age 75
