

Drinking and driving enforcement	
Roadside DUI	Drivers are selected at random along major arteries and screened,
checkpoints	and breath tested where indicated
DUI saturation patrols	Dedicated team(s) patrol streets looking for DUI violators
Retail serving practices (onsite and off-site licenses)	
Responsible beverage	Gives clerks and servers training on serving laws and some skills
service training	to identify and refuse service to minors and intoxicated patrons
Responsible beverage	To enforce state laws prohibiting service to minors and/or
service enforcement	intoxicated patrons
Reduce social availability including to youth	
Nuisance party patrols	Citation given to host(s) of large, noisy parties. Aim is to reduce number of such parties or for host to keep them small and quiet
Social host ordinances	Citation given to owner of property where underage youth are drinking
Reduce retail availability to youth	
Minor decoy operations (compliance checks)	Store clerk or bar server is cited if he or she sells alcohol to an underage youth working with law enforcement. Licensee is also penalized
Purchase surveys	Young-looking but legal-age people attempt to buy alcohol to see if they are asked for ID. If yes, a small reward is given, if no, a reminder is given.



Appendix Figure 1. Logic model for prevention of underage drinking.


