Reviewers:

Reviewer 1 requested that we update Table 1 to reflect changes elsewhere in the manuscript: "The authors have addressed all my comments from the last round. I however feel that the authors still need to adjust table 1 to reflect the "15% wastage for vaccines, and the 10% wastage for immunization supplies" as indicated in the text."

We have made this modification. The table entry now reads: "15% of vaccine procurement price per dose, 10% of immunization supplies procurement price per dose".

There were no other reviewer comments to address.

We have switched to square brackets for citations. We have updated journal abbreviations to the NCBI database format. We have confirmed that all weblinks were still current.

We also updated citations from preprints where those articles are now published.

We now use \$ to indicate US dollars throughout, and annotate that \$ means US dollars in the captions. We also include the full term for Disability Adjusted Life Years (DALYs) in every relevant table and figure caption title.
