

Fig. S4: *S. carnosus* **TM300(pFNBA4) binds to Fn fibrils of pHOB**. Representative images of immunofluorescence microscopy. pHOB were infected with *S. carnosus* TM300(pFNBA4), MOI50, for three hours; a thorough washing but no lyostaphin step was performed before fixation. Cells were stained for Fn (red) and nucleic acid (of host cells and bacteria) with Hoechst 33342 (blue).
