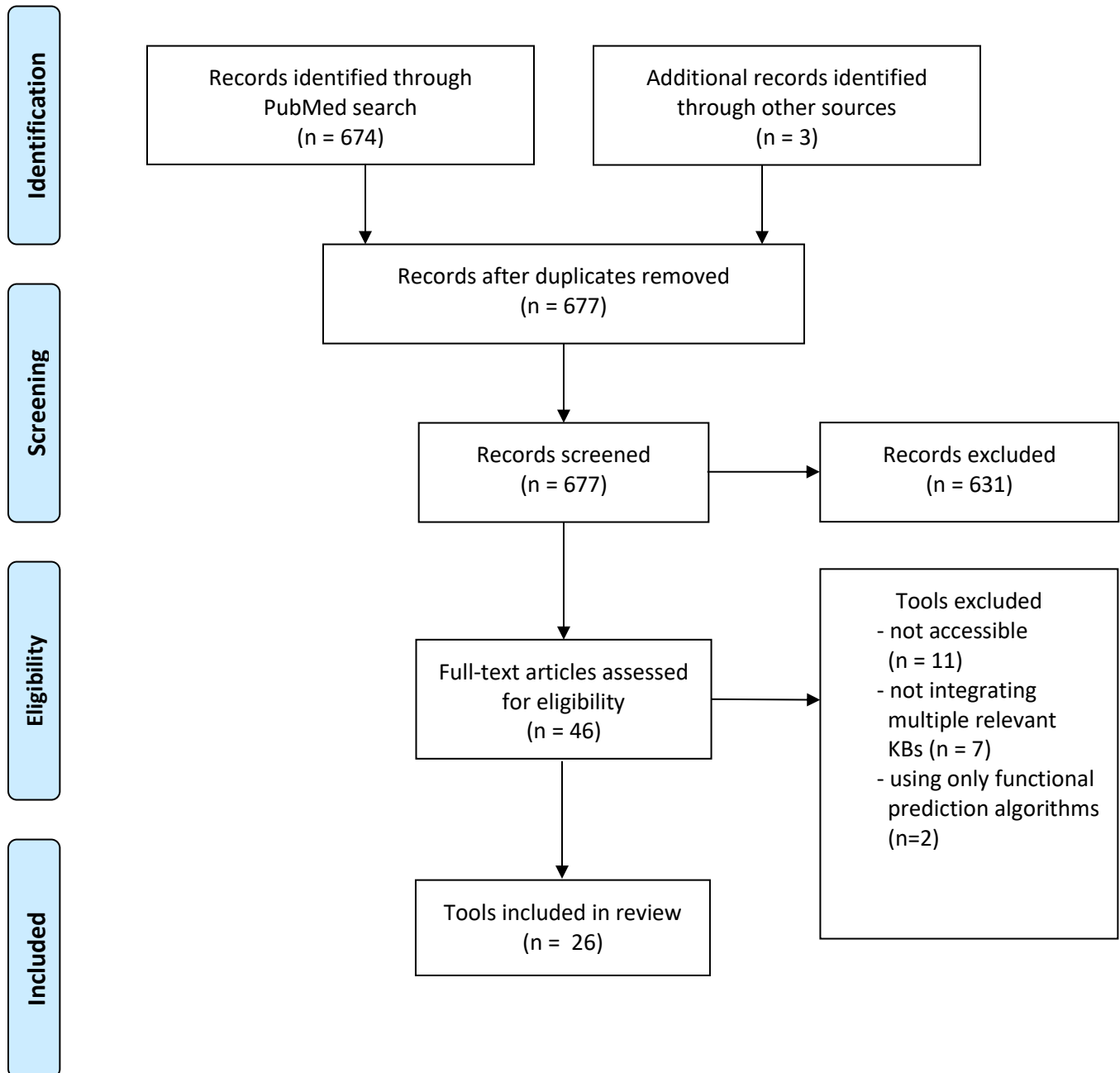


PRISMA Flow Diagram for Identifying Cancer Variant Annotation Tools
