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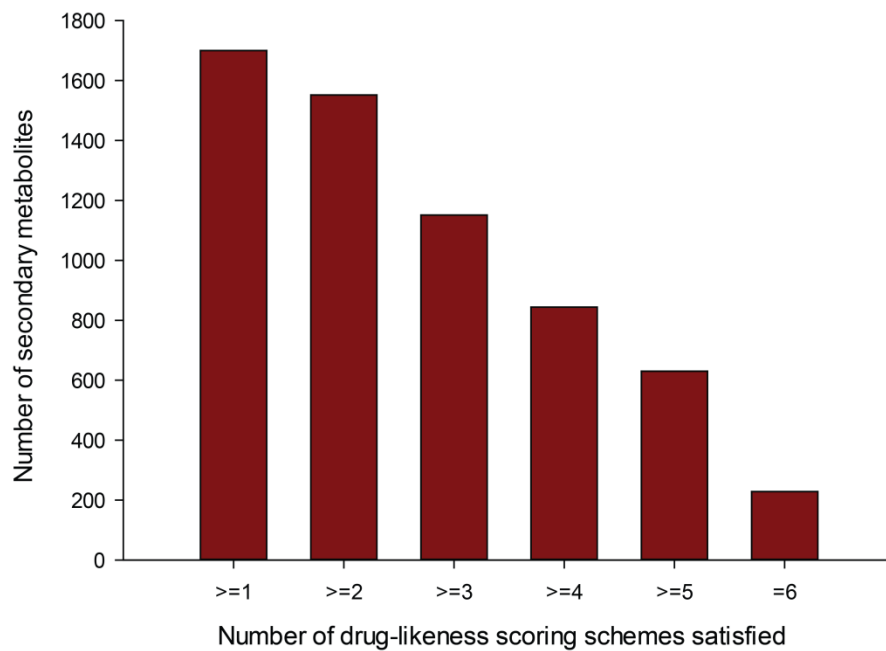

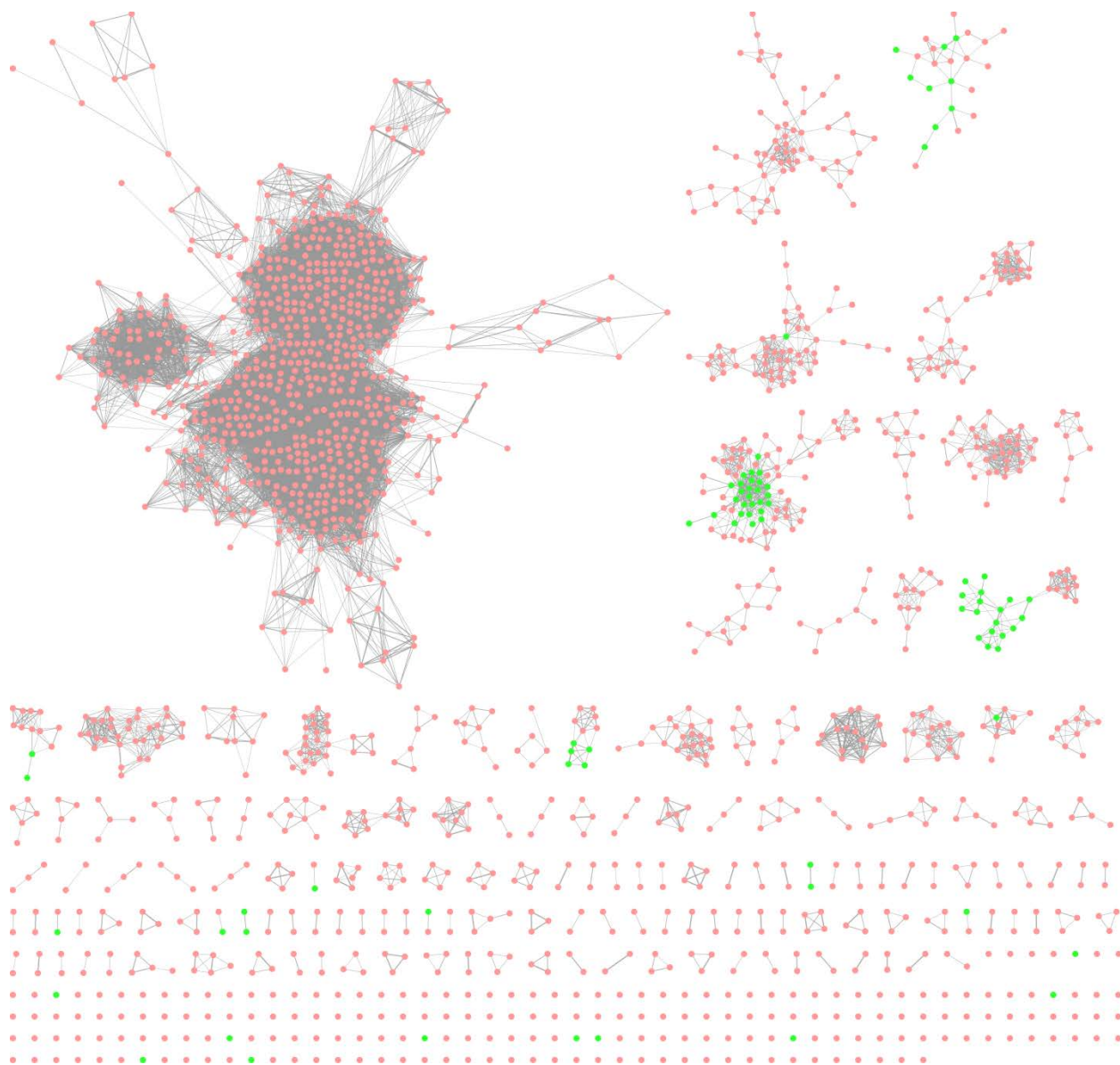

Here, the node color is green if the corresponding secondary metabolite is similar to any of the FDA approved drugs else the node color is pink. Edge thickness is proportional to the computed structural similarity between pairs of secondary metabolites.
