Supplemental Table I: Inclusion and Exclusion Criteria of the Study Cohort Inclusion Criteria:

- 1. Age \geq 18 years at the time of diagnosis
- 2. WHO category I pulmonary arterial hypertension
- 3. Mean pulmonary arterial pressure >25 mmHg at rest or >30 mmHg during exercise with a pulmonary capillary wedge pressure <15 mmHg

Exclusion Criteria:

- WHO category II pulmonary venous hypertension diagnosed by pulmonary capillary wedge pressure >15 mm Hg
- 2. Obstructive lung disease diagnosed by reduced expiratory flow rates (forced expiratory volume in one second/forced vital capacity <70% predicted)
- **3.** More than mild interstitial lung disease diagnosed by typical appearance on computed tomography
- **4.** Chronic pulmonary thromboembolic disease diagnosed by ventilation perfusion scan (other than normal or low probability), contrast-enhanced chest computed tomography or pulmonary angiography if necessary
- **5.** Pulmonary hypertension associated with sarcoidosis and other infiltrative diseases.
- **6.** Patients who were on endothelin receptor antagonists, phosphodiesterase inhibitors, or prostacyclins at the time of referral
- 7. Patients diagnosed with WHO category I pulmonary arterial hypertension before 1991
