

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Supplementary Fig. S1: Timeline and flowchart visualising how the final three datasets were determined. The yellow boxes signify the final datasets. After the successful merging of datasets, the number of participants with CRP measured and RLS assessment was 3,564 donors. For suPAR, returning donors who had previously had suPAR measured in 2010 and had RLS assessed was N=2,546. For cytokine-specific autoantibodies (c-aAb), the number of donors with c-aAb measurements and RLS assessment was N=1,478.
