eMethods

ABCD population cohort overview

The first wave of the ABCD collection offered profiling from 11,875 children aged 9-10 from 21 different sites located in 17 different states, collected from 2016 to 2018. The ABCD initiative was specifically intended to be a cohort that is diverse in gender, race and ethnicity, socioeconomic status, and urbanicity¹. Primary exclusion criteria include major medical or neurological conditions, gestational age <28 weeks or birthweight below 1200g, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) contraindications, having a parent who is not fluent in English or Spanish, history of traumatic brain injury, current diagnosis of schizophrenia, moderate/severe autism spectrum disorder, intellectual disability or substance use disorder at enrollment. Participants undergo comprehensive biennial assessments, as well as more limited interim assessments, across 10 years. ABCD Wave I and COVID-19 data were downloaded via the National Institute of Mental Health Data Archive (Data Archive Recipient #6089).

Baseline characteristic of the family system: pre-pandemic assessments

ABCD's baseline assessment includes comprehensive measures across child and parent domains: demographic and socioeconomic measures; measures of child mental health (e.g., Parent Child Behavior Checklist) and substance use; detailed family histories; trait measures of child personality and temperament (e.g., impulsivity scales); neurocognitive performance; child behaviors (e.g., digital media use, involvement in sports); child physical development; and child culture and environment (e.g., acculturation scales and family environment scales)¹⁻⁶. These and other indicators were captured at baseline using >6,000 deep profiling assessments (corresponding to >17,000 individual items). All these measures—together defining baseline, pre-pandemic family features—were entered into our multivariate pattern analysis (additional details in analysis section below). We opted for canonical correlation analysis (CCA) as the method suggests itself for probing cross-associations between variable sets in a transparent and intuitively interpretable way (as it is a linear model). While we considered a hypothesis-driven approach, we ultimately selected a hypothesis-agnostic (i.e., data-driven approach). In other words, given the highly unprecedented nature of the COVID-19 pandemic and the associated response measures, we selected an approach that could simultaneously assess all possible hypotheses. While data-driven, we note that CCA is nonetheless a linear model and hence transparent to the same degree that linear regression and Pearson correlation analyses are transparent. It is for this reason that we selected CCA over other, more 'black box' algorithms; e.g., recurrent neural networks. As such, CCA allows for transparent assessment of relationships between high dimensional variable sets, identifying cohesive 'modes' of variation that link between each dataset.

Type II error and CCA:

Importantly, in CCA, statistical significance is evaluated at the mode level; not at the level of individual variables of a given mode. This is important, as it means that our CCA approach did not involve null hypotheses testing of any single questionnaire items or health indicators. Rather, our CCA analyses is completely multivariate—in that it simultaneously considered the relationship between all baseline items and all COVID-19 questionnaire items. In other words, the null hypothesis we evaluated was whether an empirical multivariate relationship between baseline assessments and COVID-19 assessments would be detectable (i.e., robust to other sources of variance). Our elected approach therefore appropriately handled Type I and Type II errors in the context of the resulting CCA components.

We further note that our approach is consistent with other recent (non-COVID-related) analyses in general from our own ^{7,8} and others' ^{9,10} population neuroscience studies, including recent analyses of ABCD ¹¹.

Data cleaning

We conducted the following standard data cleaning steps: (1) categorical data columns were transformed to separate binary-encoded data columns; (2) non-response entries (e.g., '999' or '777') were converted to indicate missing values; (3) data columns with >50% missing values were removed entirely; (4) variables for which <250 out of ~10,000 families showed a response different from the majority response were excluded; and (5) missing data imputation was performed using non-parametric single-column replacement.

Data preprocessing

To prepare for multivariate pattern analysis, the full collection of baseline items underwent commonly carried out cleaning steps (details in SI). These recommended data cleaning procedures

are consistent with those used in similar prior multivariate pattern analyses^{12,13}. To avoid overfitting, principal component analysis was applied to the final set of baseline and COVID-19 questionnaire items, consistent with prior work and current statistical practice¹⁴⁻¹⁶.

Defining vaccination rates

State-level vaccination rates were defined using CDC data, obtained at https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#vaccinations and accessed on May 3rd, 2021.
