



Situation Review



Is my nodule cancer?

No Very low Low Intermediate Maybe High 80 %



Solid Hypoechoic nodule and:

Microcalcifications, irregular margins, extrathyroidal extension, taller than wide, interrupted rim calcification Or, Suspicious lymph nodes High suspicion (>70-90%)



Solid Hypoechoic nodule in the absence of high risk features Intermediate suspicion (10-20%)



Solid hyperechoic or isoechoic nodule with regular margins Or, Partially cystic nodule with eccentric solid component Low suspicion (5-10%)

Done with Categories



Spongiform nodules, partially cystic with no suspicious features Very low suspicion (<3%)

What Would it Mean?



Every 6 to 24 months:

- Ultrasound or neck exam.
- Blood tests

15-30 minute procedure Local anesthesia Mild to moderate pain



Recovery time varies

Daily medication

Regular blood tests

Possible Harms

Possible worry of not knowing

Discomfort

- Low risk of complications
 May not tell us if it is cancer
- 1 to 2 inch scar on the neck
- Voice complications
- Low Calcium

Surgery to remove part or all of your thyroid

Cost

Less expensive than surgery May have regular testing costs

Less expensive than surgery

Most expensive Testing and medication costs

Cost will depend on your insurance plan.
