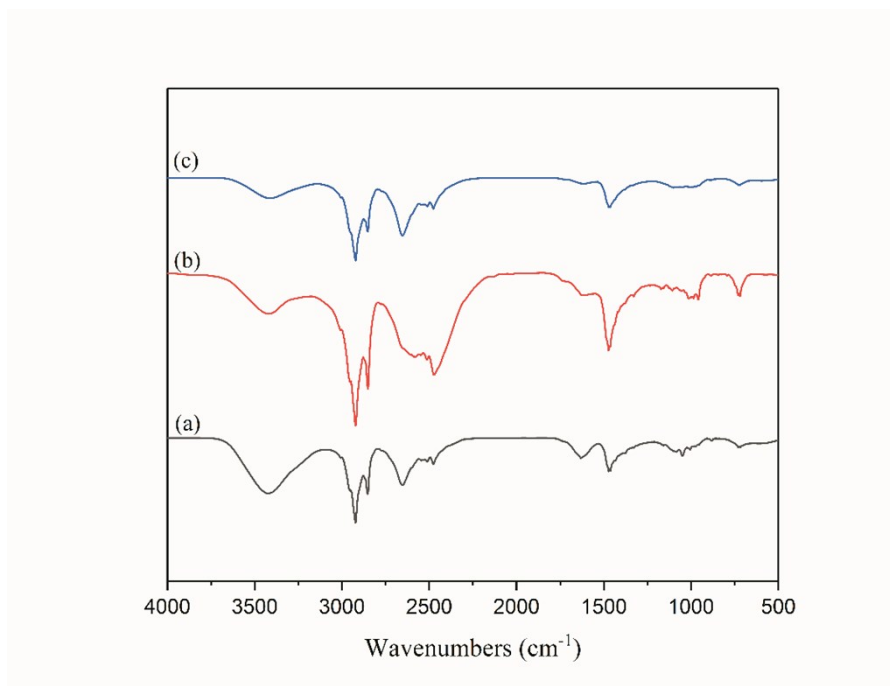

2.  $^1\text{H}$  NMR spectra of  $4C_n$ teraQ with  $n = 12, 14, 16$ .

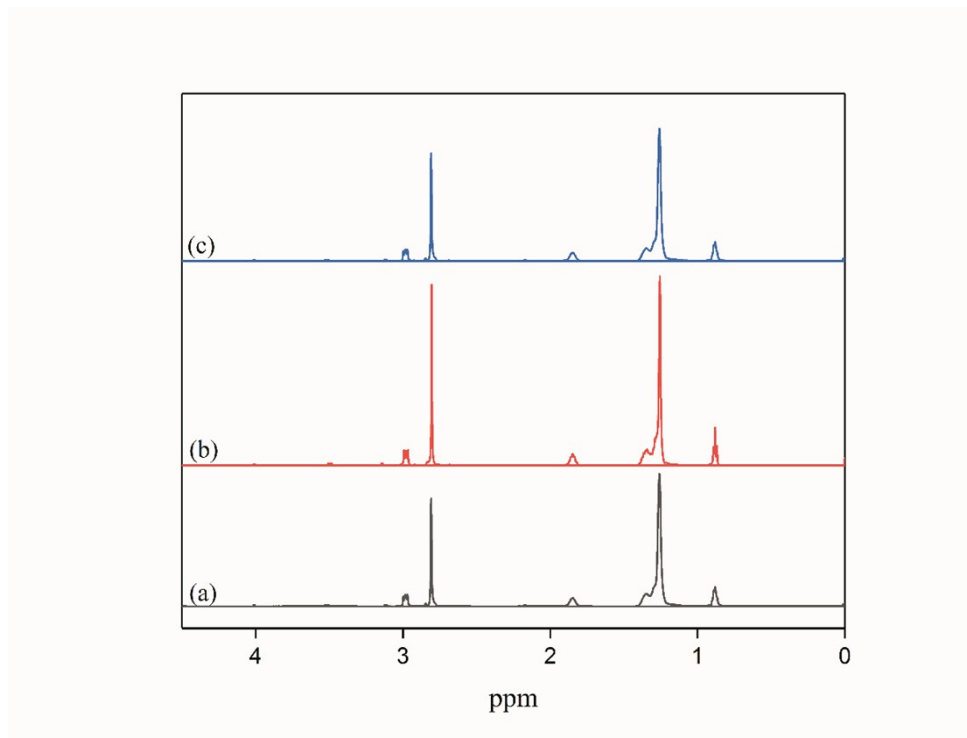
