This article entitled with "Associations of vaccine status with characteristics and outcomes of hospitalized severe COVID-19 patients in the booster era" compared the characteristics and outcomes in hospitalized severe covid-19 patients among non-vaccine, two vaccines and booster group, which could be an important guidance to better fight COVID-19 together with other clinical studies. As the author mentioned, there were several similar studies published, so this article is a bit lacking in novelty. In addition, I have some minor comments listed below:

- 1. Only male gender was included in the study, then sexual difference should be discussed.
- 2. What does the P value stand for in Table 1, 2, S1 and S2, since there were three different groups divided by no vaccine, two vaccines and booster?
